RE: SNOW ROUTES FOR THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR

Under certain special circumstances, it may be possible to have school during adverse weather conditions if an administrative decision is made to run only snow routes in the rural areas.

All in-town routes will run as usual with regular pick-up points and times.

In-town routes will also include regular stops and times within the Villages of Ashmore and Lerna, IL.

All bus riders living along a major road designated as a snow route in the rural area will be picked up at their assigned stop.

Please refer to the time listed at the nearest road intersection to your residence. All students living in the rural area, but not on a designated snow route will be picked up at the closest road intersection to your residence along a designated snow route at the designated time. Please allow time for road conditions beyond our control. If the District is going to utilize snow routes, notification to parents will be provided through 'Parent Link', and announcements will be made on local radio and television stations. Snow routes are provided on the back of this page and will be posted on the Charleston CUSD #1 website at: www.@charleston.k12.il.us.

Designated snow routes or roads:

- 1) North Route 130 from 1500 N to the City of Charleston
- 2) Bushton/Rardin Blacktop from Village of Rardin to Route 130
- 3) Ashmore/Oakland Road from 1300 N to Village of Ashmore
- 4) East Route 16 from Ashmore to the City of Charleston
- 5) East Harrison Street Road from Snake Trail Road to City of Charleston
- 6) Westfield Road from 2100 E to Route 130
- 7) Hutton Road from Hutton to the Westfield Road
- 8) South Route 130 from Diona to the City of Charleston
- 9) Lincoln Highway Road from Lerna Road West to the City of Charleston
- 10) Toledo Blacktop from Janesville to Lincoln Highway Road
- 11) 300 N from Lerna to Lincoln Highway Road
- 12) Route 16 to and from the Loxa Road
- 13) Route 316 from Loxa Road to the City of Charleston
- 14) Loxa Road from Loxa to Route 316
